The main objective of this workshop was to provide useful knowledge and regulatory practices on safety assessment in topical areas of mechanical integrity of a nuclear power plant (NPP).

The objective of this Consultancy Meeting (CS) was to explore and identify the essential elements for enhancing safety analysis capability so as to finalize the Roadmap of Safety Analysis Technical Group in the ANSN framework.

The workshop was organized by the IAEA/NS in cooperation with the KINS International Nuclear Safety School. The workshop hosted nine participants from six ANSN countries representing professional staff of nuclear safety regulatory bodies and its technical support organizations (TSO) and was moderated by the IAEA representative and Korean experts.

During the meeting, three experts from Vietnam, Indonesia and Korea, and a Technical Officer of the IAEA reviewed and discussed the Roadmap to maintain and improve the knowledge on safety analysis method, identified new technical needs for future activities and prioritized the technical elements of the Roadmap in accordance with their significance and timely.

At the workshop the participants presented their national regulatory frameworks, practices, and national nuclear power plans. At the end of the first week, a technical visit to the Yonggwang NPP Site and KEPCO Nuclear Fuel Company was organized.

As a result of the meeting, the SATG Roadmap for safety analysis capacity building and its Terms of Reference were produced. This Roadmap will be used to evaluate the level of competence in safety analysis of a Member State.

Representatives of Bangladesh, Indonesia, Malaysia, Philippines, Vietnam, and Thailand found the subjects of the workshop very useful. They highly appreciated the technical visit to the Yonggwang NPP Site and KEPCO Nuclear Fuel Company as a good opportunity to see a nuclear power plant and stages of nuclear fuel manufacturing.

In addition, SATG Activity for 2013 was drafted. It is expected that this roadmap and the terms of reference of SATG can be used as guidance to prepare the annual SATG programme for the near- and mid-term.
