Key questions (topic areas) for us to focus on:

2.1

Have appropriate role and responsibility been identified for and assigned to the regulatory body by the government in the implementation of the national policy and strategy for education and training in safety?

2.2

Has the regulatory body established processes and procedures to ensure that the requirements for education, training, qualification and competence in safety are being fulfilled by **all of its staff** engaged in activities relevant to safety?

2.3

Has the regulatory body established systematic approach in training related processes including assessment of training needs, designing and development of training programme, implementation and evaluation of their effectiveness to ensure that its staff is knowledgeable, trained, experienced and skilled in matters related to safety?
